The only way to know if you currently have COVID-19 is by getting a test. It's important to be tested to receive the medical attention you need and to protect those around you from contracting the virus. Go to summahealth.org/covidresource to learn more about the signs and symptoms.

Even if you don't have symptoms, you can receive a COVID-19 test.*

This is not an antibody test. This test is to determine if you actively have the COVID-19 virus.

Sunday, June 28 from 11 a.m. – 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. – 5 p.m.

- If you have an insurance card, please bring it, but insurance coverage is not required.
- There is no out-of-pocket cost or co-pay at the testing event.
- Please bring identification, if you have it and be prepared to share your name, date of birth, address and phone number.
